




As we explained in <u>our report about the video visitation industry</u> that wants jails to replace free in-person jail visits with expensive computer video chats, not everyone has computers at home or high-speed internet. It's clear — and should be no surprise to industry leaders — that access is the most restricted in poor households, in African-American and Latino households, and in the homes of older people.




