Good morning,

The Parole Board does have a special condition that the commissioners can select that tells the parolee that they cannot associate with gang members or other felons. We also have a standard condition that any individual on parole that has a victim in their case cannot have any contact with the victim or ask anyone to contact the victim on their behalf. If the commissioner's deem it necessary, they can write a no contact order as a condition of parole with a specific person if they deem them a potential risk factor or they think that the specific individual would cause issues / become an obstacle with them being successful while on parole.
