STATE RATES OF INCARCERATION BY RACE

In 1997, The Sentencing Project published a policy report examining racial disparities in imprisonment among the states. That report, *Intended and Unintended Consequences: State Racial Disparities in Imprisonment*, revealed that African Americans were more than seven times as likely to be imprisoned as whites, based on 1994 data. Variations among the states were quite broad, ranging from a black/white disparity of 3.43 in Idaho to 22.77 in Minnesota.

The following table provides an updated analysis of racial disparities in the use of incarceration. The table provides combined jail and prison incarceration rates for Whites and Blacks for 2001, with states ranked by the Black/White disparity ratio.

This table is not entirely comparable with the previous analysis for two reasons. This report includes data from state prisons as well as local jails, whereas the report released in 1997 only used state prison data. Additionally, the previous report was based on Bureau of Justice Statistics data on race of prisoners, but not ethnicity. Therefore, Hispanic prisoners were included in either the White or Black categories. The table in this report is based on data that treats Hispanics separately. In general, since most Hispanics are categorized as White by race, the White rates of incarceration may be lower in the current table than those in the previous report, and the resulting Black/White ratio higher.
